SAFETY POLICY

PROTECTING THE FEET

Whereas, the Town of Merryville requires all Maintenance Personnel to wear steel toed boots to comply with the Town of Merryville's safety program.

The Town of Merryville's maintenance personnel must wear boots made with impact resistant toes that should be able to withstand hazards involving the feet and hard, sharp, and other dangerous objects. The toes of the boots should be able to resist punctures from nails, spikes or other metal objects that can pierce boots and protects a worker's toes if a heavy object were to roll over his or her toes.

The Town of Merryville will furnish one (1) pair of steeled toe boots per calendar year.

The Town of Merryville will pay up to \$ 100.00 (one hundred dollars and no cents) per pair of boots.

The employee must have made his or her 90 day probationary period to receive the boots.

The boots shall be the property of the Town of Merryville and the event that said employee is no longer employed by the Town, whether it be by resignation or termination, the boots will remain the property of the town and must be turned in with keys and uniforms.
